- **Proper kitchens and bathrooms** – If these are too small, too basic, or just not fit-for-purpose, they get neglected—and that neglect spreads.

- **Regular inspections** – A quick walk-through every few weeks reminds workers that upkeep matters.
- **A bond system** – Even a small refundable bond makes people more likely to take care of their space.
- **Follow through** –If something gets trashed and nothing happens, workers learn there are no real consequences. Once that happens, **standards slip fast.**
